



Kings Bromley Neighbourhood Area Designation

Kings Bromley Parish Council applied to Lichfield District Council for land within the District Council boundary to be designated as a Neighbourhood Area in December 2019 (in accordance with Regulation 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012, as amended). The Parish Council provided the following information as part of their application:

- A map of the proposed Neighbourhood Area; and
- An application letter submitted by the Parish Council to the District Council, including statements on why the area was appropriate for designation and that the organisation making the application was the 'relevant body'.

The application for the Neighbourhood Area designation was for the whole of the Kings Bromley Parish only. The District Council is therefore required to designate the Neighbourhood Area as requested and no public consultation on the application is required (in accordance with The Neighbourhood Planning Regulations (2012, as amended) Regulation 5A).

On 19 December 2019, Lichfield District Council (via delegated authority) resolved to designate the Kings Bromley Parish as the Kings Bromley Neighbourhood Area.
