Whereas during certain hours on Sunday 8 November 2020 parts of the following streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed the Lichfield District Council pursuant to powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 do HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said street on the said day the following regulations shall be observed:

The streets known as **Beacon Street** (from its junction with Gaia Lane to its junction with Bird Street), **Bird Street** (from its junction with Beacon Street to its junction with Swan Road), **The Friary** (from the junction with Swan Road to the junction with Bore Street) and **Bore Street** (from the junction with Breadmarket Street to the junction with The Friary) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 10.00 and 12.00 noon on **Sunday 8 November 2020**

The penalty for infringement of the said regulations is a fine not exceeding one thousand pounds.

Emergency traffic and required access to properties will be routed under the Organisers supervision.
