TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STREETS ORDER UNDER SECTION 21

OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT, 1847 FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ETC

SHERIFF'S RIDE

Saturday 5 September 2020

Whereas during certain hours on **Saturday 5 September 2020**, parts of the following streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed the Lichfield District Council pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 do **HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT** that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said streets on the said days the following regulations shall be observed:

1. The streets known as Bird Street, Bore Street, Conduit Street, Dam Street, Market Street, Breadmarket Street and Tamworth Street (from its junction with Conduit Street to its junction with Lombard Street) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 9.30 and 11.30 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**
2. The streets known as The Friary (from Swan Road to Bore Street), Swan Road, Beacon Street, Pinfold Road, Cross in Hand Lane East and Cross in Hand Lane West (to Sheriffs Ride Bridleway), Cross over A51 (around the Plant Plot area), Grange Lane (from its junctions with A5192 and A515), Park Lane from junction with A515 to Elmhurst Village at Nash Lane, Watery Lane (from Eastern Avenue to Curborough Hall Farm) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 9.30 and 12 noon on **Saturday 5 September 2020**.
3. The lane known as Netherstowe Lane (from Spring Road to Curborough House Farm) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 10.30 and 12.30 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**
4. The streets known Burton Road (Network Rail Depot to junction with Eastern Avenue) and Cappers Lane (from Eastern Avenue to A38) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 11.45 and 13.00 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**
5. The street known as Darnford Lane (from Tudor Rise to Marsh Lane) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 12 noon and 13.30 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**.
6. The streets known as Old London Road (from A38 to Whitehouse Farm), Unnamed Lane (from A5 to Old London Road) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 15.00 and 15.45 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**
7. The streets known as Watling Street (from A5127 to Claypit Lane), Wall Lane, Fossey Lane shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 16.00 and 17.15 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**
8. The streets known as Abnalls Lane (from Pipe Hall Farm to Beacon Street) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 16.45 and 18.00 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**.
9. The streets known as Beacon Street (from Abnalls Lane to The Close), Dam Street, Market Street (Dam Street to Breadmarket Street), Breadmarket Street, Bore Street, The Friary (from Swan Road to Bore Street) shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including pedal cycles between the hours of 17.00 and 19.00 on **Saturday 5 September 2020**.

All the above Road Closures are rolling road closures and are to ensure the safety of spectators and riders from the start to the finish of the Sheriff's Ride.

The Penalty for infringement of the said Regulations is a fine not exceeding one thousand pounds. Emergency traffic will be routed under the Organisers supervision.
