

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION &
CERTIFICATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

Highways Act 1980 Section 119

The Lichfield District Council

(Public Footpath No. 0.333 (Part) in the Parish of Burntwood)

Public Path Diversion Order 2022

The above Order was confirmed and certified on the 25th January 2023. The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert that part of footpath No. 0.333 (Part) in the Parish of Burntwood commencing off Burntwood Way at Grid Reference 403825 308690 (Point A on the Plan) and proceeding in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 461 metres to Grid Reference 404220 308458 (Point B on the Plan) onto a line commencing off Burntwood Way at Grid Reference 403825 308690 (Point A on the Plan) and running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 28 metres to Grid Reference 403851 308698 (Point C on the Plan) then turning and running in a generally south south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 464 metres to Grid Reference 404050 308281 (Point D on the Plan), then in a south easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to Grid Reference 404087 308266 (Point E on the Plan) before turning in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 242 metres to Grid Reference 404220 308458 (Point B on the Plan) as shown on the Order map.

A copy of the confirmed and certified Order and the Order Map may be viewed on the Council's website or at the offices of Lichfield District Council, District Council House, Frog Lane, Lichfield between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased.

The Order comes into force from the date it is certified, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question the validity, or that any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended or Wildlife and Countryside Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirements of the Acts, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Acts, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 of the Act, within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published, make application to the High Court.
