NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER Highways Act 1980 Section 119 The Lichfield District Council

(Public Footpath No.42 (Part) in the Parish of Fradley and Streethay) Public Path Diversion Order 2023

The above Order was confirmed and certified on the 22 December 2023. The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert that part of footpath No. 42 (Part) in the Parish of Fradley and Streethay commencing at its junction with Public Footpath, Fradley and Streethay No 30 at Grid Reference SK 1574 1386 (Point A on the Plan) and running in a generally westerly direction for approximately 442 meters to Grid Reference SK 1529 1387 (Point B on the Plan) and then in a south westerly direction for approximately 108 meters to Grid Reference SK 1520 1381 (Point C on the Plan), before running again in a westerly direction for a further 138 meters to Grid Reference SK 1507 1381 (Point D on the Plan) on to a line commencing at its junction with Public Footpath, Fradley and Streethay No 30 at Grid Reference SK 1573 1388 (Point F on the Plan), and proceeding in a westerly direction along the northern side of the drainage ditch for a distance of approximately 365 meters to Grid Reference SK 1537 1387 (Point E on the Plan) then turring and following the northern side of the ditch in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 307 meters to Grid Reference SK 1507 1381 (Point D on the Plan) as shown on the Order map.

A copy of the confirmed and certified Order and the Order Map may be viewed on the Council's website or at the offices of Lichfield District Council, District Council House, Frog Lane, Lichfield between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday.

The Order comes into force from the date it is certified, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question the validity, or that any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended or Wildlife and Countryside Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirements of the Acts, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Acts, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 of the Act, within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published, make application to the High Court.
