

NOTICE OF ADOPTION

THE COMMUNITY INFASTRUCTURE LEVY REGULATIONS 2010 (AS AMENDED) PLANNING ACT 2008 (AS AMENDED) COMMUNITY INFASTRUCTURE LEVY (CIL) - CHARGING SCHEDULE

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge on development, calculated on a £ per square metre (sq.m) basis of development. CIL is intended to be used to help fund infrastructure to support the development of an area.

This statement is published by Lichfield District Council to fulfil the requirements of Section 213 (3b) of the Planning Act 2008 (as amended) to set out in detail the Council's response to the Examiner's report and Regulation 25 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended) 'Approval and Publication of a Charging Schedule'.

Lichfield District Council formally adopted the Community Infrastructure Levy CIL Charging Schedule at its Full Council meeting on the 19th April 2016. The Charging Schedule will be implemented from the 13th June 2016.

CIL will apply to new development covered by the CIL Charging Schedule and granted planning permission or otherwise on or after the 13th June 2016.
