This Order is made by Lichfield District Council ('the Authority') under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ('the 1990 Act'), because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: Residential development off watery Lane, Curborough under reference 21/01859/REMM & 22/00040/REMM

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Lichfield District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall take effect on the date on which Lichfield District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.
- 4. Redrow homes Midlands, Redrow house, Kinsall green, Wilnecote, Tamworth, Staffs B77 5PX is hereby required to pay the cost of carrying out the works to bring the new footpath into a fit condition.
- 5. Where immediately before the date on which a footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
