The effect of the Order will be to divert that part of footpath No.11 (Part) in the Parish of Curborough & Elmhurst commencing at Grid Reference SK 1258 1191 (Point A on the Plan) and running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 51 metres to Grid Reference SK 1269 11812 (Point C on the Plan on to a line commencing at Grid Reference SK 1258 1191 (Point A on the Plan), then proceeding in a southerly, then easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to Grid Reference SK 1260 1181 (Point B on the Plan), then continuing easterly for a short distance before turning and running south easterly for a distance of approximately 119 metres to its junction with Public footpath, Curborough & Elmhurst No 12 at Grid Reference SK 1269 1183 (Point D on the Plan) as shown on the order plan.

The Order will come into force once Lichfield District Council certify that the new footpath has been provided to a satisfactory standard. Any person aggrieved by the Order, wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or any regulation made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be stopped up as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Lichfield District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall take effect on the date on which Lichfield District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.
- 4. Redrow homes Midlands, Redrow house, Kinsall green, Wilnecote, Tamworth, Staffs B77 5PX is hereby required to pay the cost of carrying out the works to bring the new footpath into a fit condition.
- 5. Where immediately before the date on which a footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

Part II Description of Site of New Path


