



Points to bear in mind

- We expect work which we aid to be sympathetic to the character and importance of the buildings in question, and to be done to a standard which will ensure durability and value for money. We can provide full technical advice on these matters.
- Do not start work before we have offered a grant unless you have obtained our written approval to do so. We do not pay grant for work which has already been carried out.
- For all but simple and straightforward work, we would expect the involvement of a professional (a qualified architect or building surveyor) to produce a repair specification and schedule of work upon which to invite tenders (normally three) and subsequently to check work and be responsible for its certification.
- You will not normally be eligible for grant unless you have owned the building for more than two years.
