

GROW YOUR WOORKSPACE

Grants worth up to £65,000 are available to help businesses across rural areas of Stoke-on-Trent and Staffordshire to convert under-utilised buildings or construct new workspaces.

The Rural Enterprise Programme will offer grants to sympathetically convert under-utilised buildings or construct new rural workspaces, to help rural businesses increase productivity and create jobs.

How much is available?

Capital grants of between £10,000 and £65,000 are available or up to 40% of the total eligible costs of the project, whichever is the lowest. You must be able to provide a minimum of 60% as match funding.

What types of projects can be funded?

Eligible end uses will include manufacturing, creative industries or service businesses and office premises.

What costs are eligible?

Grants can be used for costs directly associated with the refurbishment or construction of workspaces.

Who can apply?

Eligible businesses should be SME's i.e. must employ less than 250 people and have a turnover less than €50m and/or a balance sheet total not exceeding €43m.



The Programme will operate across Stoke-on-Trent and Staffordshire's rural areas and hub towns such as **Cheadle**, **Leek**, **Rugeley**, **Stone** and **Uttoxeter**.
